

Capture Your Share of the Sun!

Satilla REMC is pleased to present our cooperative solar project. Our site consists of a 1 megawatt solar electricity generation site adjacent to our Alma office in Bacon County. This 5-acre facility consists of 4,280 solar panels and is expected to produce approximately 2 million kilowatt-hours of solar electricity per year.

Pricing and Energy Production

Blocks of solar electricity cost \$18 each per month. Each block, equivalent to about 4.3 solar panels, is expected to produce approximately 140-180 kilowatt-hours of solar energy monthly. Energy output will vary due to the sun's angle, the time of year, the number of cloudy days in the month and other factors.

Availability

You will be able to sign up for up to three (3) blocks of solar electricity. Requests for more than three blocks will be handled on a case-by-case basis. Locations with a history of relatively low energy usage may be limited to less than three (3) blocks. Only residences served by the Satilla REMC electric grid can participate.

Sign-ups

Sign-ups are on a first-come, first-served basis. Call us at 912-632-7222 to apply. We are not able to take online requests

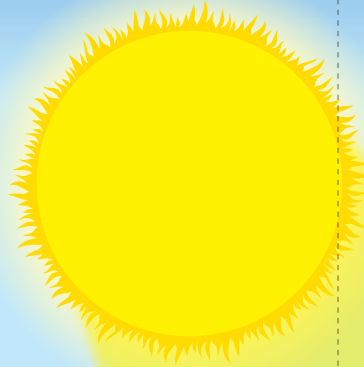
at this time. If blocks are sold out, a waiting list is available.

Billing

You will be billed \$18 for each block of solar electricity. The kilowatt-hours produced by your block in each calendar month will offset the same number of kilowatt-hours on your bill. If your block produces more kilowatt-hours than you use during your billing period, you will receive a credit for the excess. You will be informed of any price change at least 30 days in advance.

Length of Commitment

You can discontinue your solar energy commitment at any time by notifying us. However, when you choose to discontinue, you will not be able to re-enroll for 12 months. If you leave the program, Satilla REMC cannot guarantee there will be availability if you decide to rejoin.
